Thomas W. Weible, Jr., 83, of Lebanon, passed away on Wednesday May 15, 2019 at WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital. Thomas was the husband of Sandra (Schaak) Weible, with whom he celebrated 54 years in marriage. Thomas was born in Lebanon on November 19, 1935 to the late Thomas W. Weible, Sr. and Sarah E.
