



## Wade E. Bell

April 22, 1921 - June 18, 2017

Wade E. Bell, Jr., 96, of Annville, passed away on Sunday June 18, 2017, at Cedar Haven. He was the husband of the late Helene V. "Pinky" Bell, who passed away in 2004.

Wade was born in Lebanon on April 22, 1921, to the late Wade E. Bell Sr. and Mary (Brown) Bell. He graduated from Lebanon High School in 1938 and served as Treasurer for its reunion committee which held lots of class reunions. In 1942 he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served during WWII as a Master Sergeant, seeing action in Germany and associated countries during 1944- 45. He reenlisted and served overseas during The Korean War.

He was a former member of the Annville United Methodist Church. A resident of Annville for 60 years, he participated in many local organizations including Rotary Club, Kiwanis Club, American Legion, and served many years as treasurer of the Annville Community swimming pool. He and his wife traveled throughout all the continental United States, having traveled to each state. He also visited Hawaii on his way home from Korea in 1951. He enjoyed golf and bowling which he continued well into his early 90's.

Most of his professional life he worked in the banking business, having worked for several banks in Lebanon, Annville and Palmyra. He retired in 1979.

Surviving is a daughter, Bonnie, and her husband, Glenn Snavely, of Port St. Lucie FL. Wade was preceded in death by his sister Betty.

Memorial services will be held on Saturday, June 24, 2017, at 11AM from Kreamer Funeral Home and Crematory Inc., 618 E. Main Street, Annville. Interment will be at the convenience of the family in Indiantown Gap National Cemetery, Annville.
