Walter C. "Walt" Haftl, 91, a 10-year resident of Gambrills, MD, and previously of Lehigh Township, PA, died April 13, 2014.

Born March 13, 1923, in West Coplay (Stiles), PA, Walt served his country overseas during World War II. Upon his return, he received his GED, and went on to earn a B.S. from Moravian College and a M.S. in Business from Columbia University in NY.
