Walter N. McKinnon, III, 71, of Lebanon passed away on January 23, 2018, at the Penn State Hershey Medical Center. He was the husband of Nancy A. Marks McKinnon. They would have celebrated their 5th wedding anniversary in June.

Born in Bethlehem on January 1, 1947, he was the son of the late Walter N. and Verla (Palarmo) McKinnon, Jr. He graduated from Bethlehem High School with the Class of 1964.
