



## Wesley G. Houser

November 17, 1921 - September 23, 2010

Wesley G. Houser, 88, of 14 Kindred Place, Annville formerly of Hershey died Thursday September 23, 2010 in the Ephrata Community Hospital. He was the husband of the late Helen Benedict Houser who died in 2000. Born in Sheridan, PA on November 17, 1921, he was the son of the late George and Clara Heilman Houser. Wesley began his career as a research engineer at Penn State, University Park and in 1968 accepted a job as Assistant Professor of Electrical Engineering at the Capital Campus of Penn State University, Harrisburg. He was a U.S. army Veteran of WW II, a 1939 graduate of Lebanon High School, graduated from Lehigh University with a degree in Electrical Engineering, and received his Master's Degree in Electrical Engineering from Penn State University. He was a member of the Church of the Redeemer United Church of Christ, Hershey, the Hershey Italian Lodge, and was an avid golfer. Surviving are a daughter Mary Jane wife of John Mark Aichele of Hershey, a son David Houser of Hershey, a sister Mildred Beveloque of East Petersburg, four grandchildren, and one great grandchild. He was preceded in death by two brothers George and Warren Houser, and three sisters Verna Bruder, Mary Hilda Schell, and Mae Kimmel.
