William H. Heeter, 89, of Annville, passed away on Tuesday, December 9th, 2025, at the Lebanon Valley Home in Annville. He is survived by his loving wife of over 67 years, Eileen J. (Boland) Heeter.

Born in Pottstown, PA on October 9th, 1936, he was the son of the late Howard W. and Loretta S. (Frederick) Heeter. Bill had worked at Lebanon Valley Offset, Annville as a photolithographer.
