William K. Watson, 82, of Annville, passed away on Friday, September 1, 2023, at home. He was predeceased by his wife of over 58 years, June E. Watson.

Born in Lebanon on March 8, 1941, he was the son of the late William I. and Debra R. (Sullivan) Watson. After graduating from Lebanon High School with the Class of 1959, Bill served in the Air Force. He then attended Lebanon Valley College earning a BA in History, and the University of Oregon earning a MA in Japanese History. He worked at the Pennsylvania Historical & Museum Commission as a historian and placed many historic sites on the National Historic Register. Over the years, Bill also served on the Annville Township Planning Commission and was active with the Friends of Old Annville. Bill enjoyed travelling, gardening, cooking, painting, and sewing.

Surviving is a brother, Thomas G. Watson, husband of Kathleen A. of Lebanon; niece Lori Wright; nephew, David Light; and brother-in-law Alvin Light, and his wife Sandy. He was preceded in death by a niece Anne Marie Light.
