Wilson L. Aungst, 85, of Elizabethtown passed away Tuesday, November 18, 2025 at M.S. Hershey Medical Center. He was the husband of Nancy (Herner) Aungst to whom he was married 64 years.

Born in Pine Grove, he was a son of the late Paul and Grace (Raudenbush) Aungst.
