Wynanne F. Demler, 73, of Lebanon, passed away on Saturday, November 22, 2025. She was the wife of Thomas E. Demler. On December 13th, they would have celebrated their 29th wedding anniversary.

Born in Lebanon on August 4, 1952, she was the daughter of the late Richard and Grace (Daub) Fortna. She was a member of the Northern Lebanon Class of 1970. Wynanne retired as a 2nd grade teacher from the Fredericksburg Elementary School. She was an active member of the Bunker Hill Evangelical Congregational Church and served on the church board. She was also a member of the Bunker Hill Grange, Daughters of the American Revolution, the Dutch singing group Die Schwadare Schalle (Sounds of Swatara), Pennsylvania German Zammelaaf, the Northern Lebanon High School Alumni Band, various book clubs and a past Board Member of North Lebanon Township Authority.

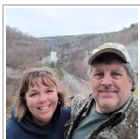
